


Hawks Prairie Kiosk Closure





Lacey Timberland LIBRARY RENOVATION

Planned Fall remodel moved to Summer 2020

Drive-up Book Drops are only open Tuesday - Saturday, 1 - 5 p.m.

Library Takeout service dependent on construction. Patrons will be notified when holds pick up can begin.



Lacey is undergoing a renovation that will begin mid-July and is expected to be completed by early October 2020. Due to impacts of construction on library staff and work areas, Library Takeout service for Lacey Timberland Library will be delayed until late July and we will notify our community when a date has been determined.

Holds will remain at the Lacey Timberland Library unless individuals contact TRL to request their holds be transferred to the Olympia location (transfers may take several days due to limited courier service). Transfer requests can be made by emailing AskLib@trl.org or via the Live Chat feature on TRL.org Monday - Friday, 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Improvements will include:

- Installation of a single-occupancy family restroom
- Replacement of all service desks with height adjustable stations to accommodate all patrons
- Creation of a check-in room to consolidate materials return and processing in one area
- New library layout to improve health and safety of staff and patrons in response to COVID-19




It's not too late to sign up for Summer Library Program!




