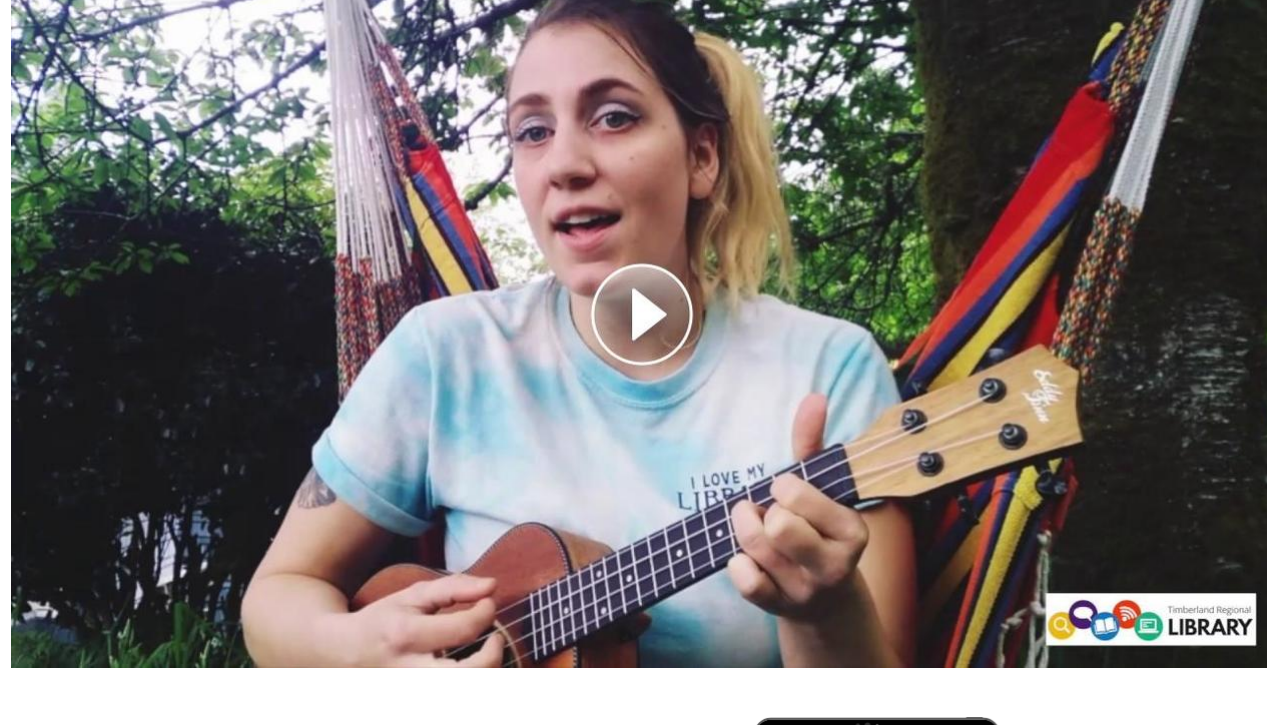


Summer Library Program Has Gone Virtual!

- and have fun at home

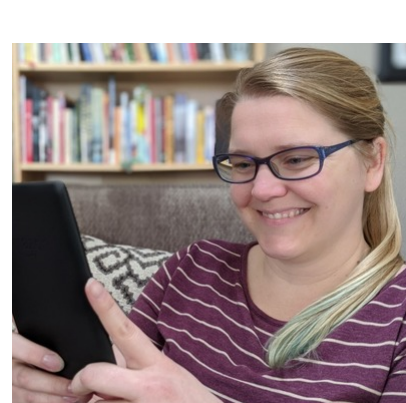

Now is a great time to plan your summer activities. While things may look different right now, the library is still here for you, even while our buildings are closed.



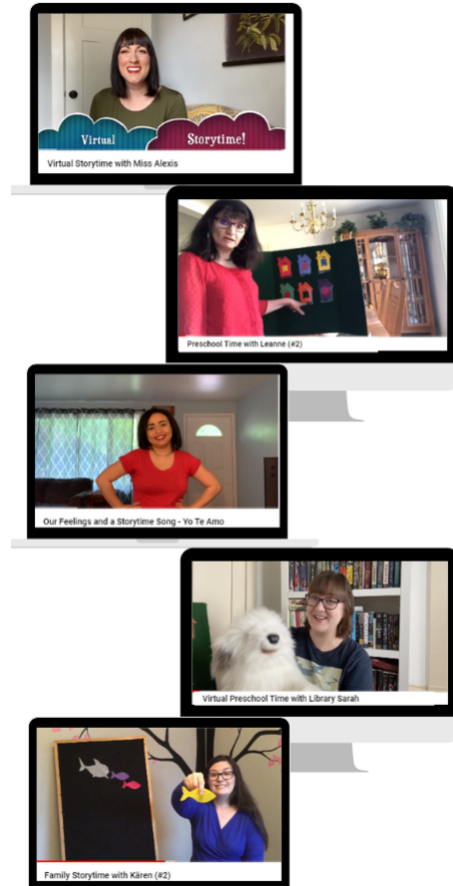
Participating in the Summer Library Program is for All Ages!

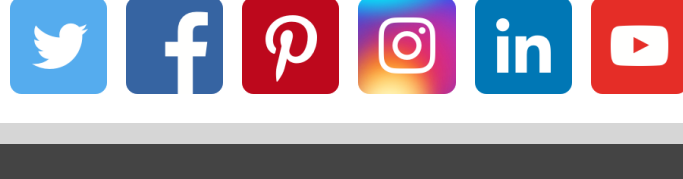
