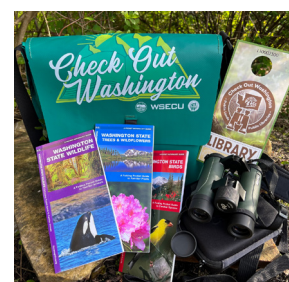

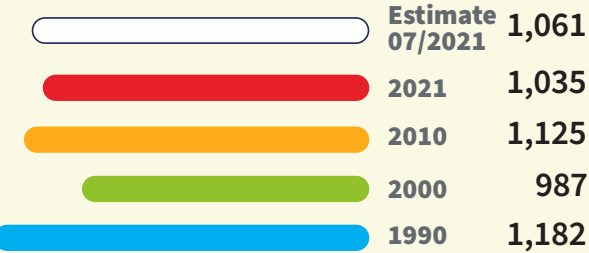
Kiosk Service includes Mobile Services Specialist to processes and delivers material, performs a variety of information services and programming functions.

Pop Up Events: Beginning May 18, schedule changed from 2 hours once a month to 1.5 hour twice a month. Adds an extra hour a month.

Setup/Take down Time: Setup takes 30 minutes. Take down takes 15 minutes.

Drive Time: Round trip to Morton is 140 minutes, previously done the same day as Mineral's pop-up, only half of the drive time is represented Jan – May 17.

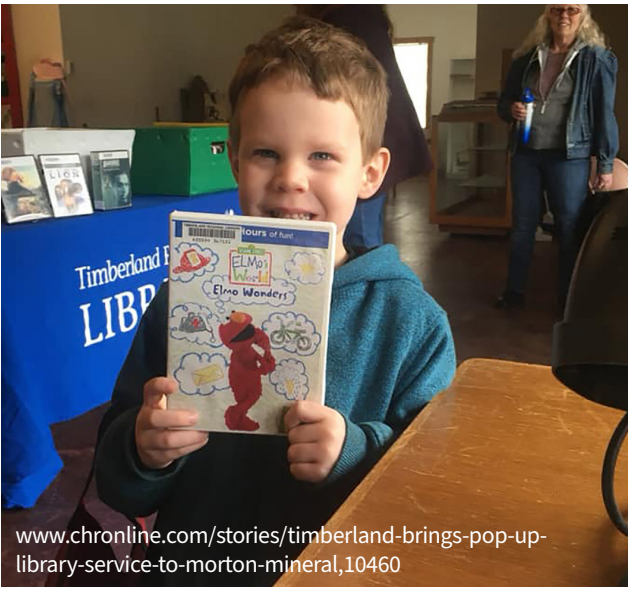
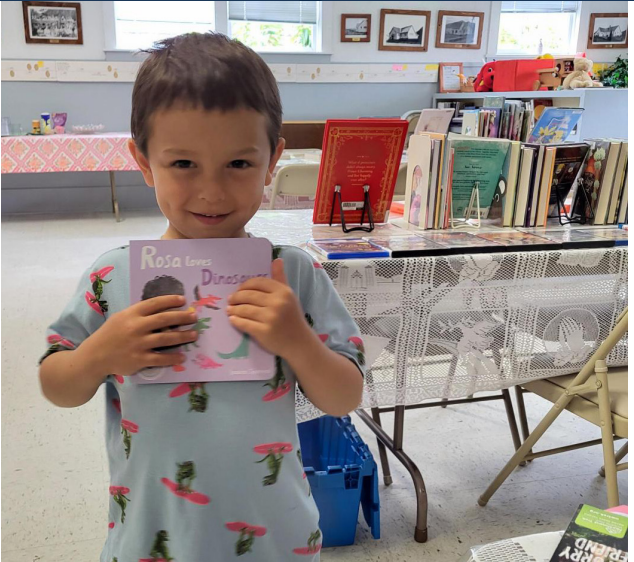
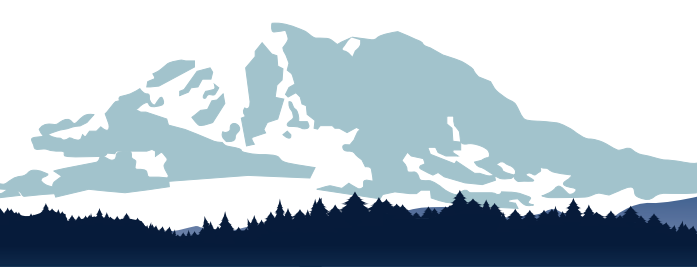
